

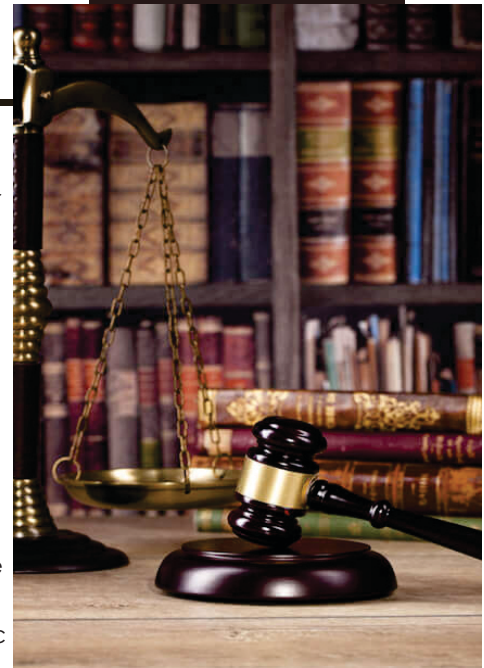
LAW STREAM
